Studies have shown regenerative therapies stimulate and accelerate your own body's natural abilities. One of the most effective Regenerative therapies is **Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) Injections.**



Platelet Rich Plasma

Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) therapy utilizes platelets taken from the patient's own blood.

Platelets

Platelets normally circulate within the blood stream and are responsible for blood clotting and initiating a healing response in an injury. Many injuries do not heal adequately and can lead to chronic pain and loss of function of the injured area. Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) therapy allows us to harvest the patient's own platelets and re-inject those concentrated platelets into the site of the injury to initiate the body's abilities and improvement of function. This is typically done under image guidance such as ultrasound and/or fluoroscopy.

PRP has shown to be successful in not only relieving pain, but also in jump-starting the body's natural processes.
